Purpose of This Notice

You have legal rights regarding the handling of your personal data. We aim to ensure that your personal data is collected, stored, and processed correctly, lawfully, and fairly. ZCoordinate's Principles for Processing Personal Data

Storage Limitation: Data must not be retained longer than necessary for its processing purposes, except for archiving, research, or statistical purposes.

Rights of Data Subjects: Personal data must be processed in accordance with your rights, including:

Accessing your data.

Preventing processing for direct marketing.

Amending inaccuracies.

Objecting to processing that may cause harm.

Security: Data must be processed securely, protecting it against unauthorized access, loss, or damage.

Your Rights

Under certain circumstances, you have the following rights regarding your personal data:

Access: Request access to your personal data to verify lawful processing.

Correction: Request correction of any incomplete or inaccurate information.

Erasure: Request deletion of your personal data when there is no valid reason for processing.

Objection: Object to processing based on legitimate interests or direct marketing purposes.

Restriction: Request suspension of processing your personal data.

Transfer: Request the transfer of your personal information to another party.
